Rules and Bylaws 2010

Tee Times

- 1) Tee times may be made up to one week in advance.
- 2) Tee time requests must include all the names for the group.
- 3) Members completing rounds in reasonable time will be given preference for starting times.
- 4) Members are required to sign up in the Pro Shop.
- 5) Members are required to sign up in the Pro Shop for additional holes prior to play.
- 6) Starting times may only be altered by the starter.
- 7) **Tipping the starter is prohibited.** Violation may result in expulsion of member and termination of starter.

Guests

- 1) **No guests will be permitted to play Saturday, Sundays or Holidays before 11:00 during season.**
- 2) **Members may not have the same guest more than once a month during season.**
- 3) **Members are responsible for their guest's behavior and adherence to the club rules.**
- 4) **Member must play with their guests; there will be NO unaccompanied guests.**
- 5) **Members may not have more than 3 guests at one time.**

Tournaments

- 1) Members wishing to participate in club tournaments must have a USGA handicap at Baiting Hollow Club.
- 2) Members playing in club tournaments will be given a preference for starting times.
- 3) Only full members are entitled to enter tournaments scheduled for Weekends and Holidays.

General

- 1) Members must adhere to the ranger's instructions. Failure to cooperate will result in loss of desired starting time or suspension. **Slow groups may be asked to pick up and move to the next hole or skip a hole. Failure to cooperate with a ranger's direction will result in a suspension.**

- 2) Members are required to post all scores. Failure to report all scores will result in a penalty score.
- 3) Members shall familiarize themselves with “Ready Golf”, and employ proper golf etiquette
- 4) *All members must start play from the first hole*, unless otherwise instructed by the staff.
- 5) *Jumping from hole to hole is strictly prohibited.*
- 6) Golfers stopping for lunch will forfeit their order of play and will resume as directed by the starter.
- 7) Proper attire is expected of members and their guests. (Jeans of any kind are strictly prohibited). A copy of our Dress Code is available in the Pro Shop.
- 8) Metal spikes are prohibited.
- 9) Golf carts are mandatory at all times. No children, under the age of 16, are permitted to drive golf carts.
- 10) Occasionally the club will be closed for outings.
- 11) *The club will be open from March 10th, 2010 through December 24th, 2010 and closed on Thanksgiving Day.*
- 12) Any complaints or suggestions pertaining to employees must be made in writing and submitted to the manager. Any complaint filed against members breaking rules or bylaws should be in writing and submitted to the manager.
- 13) Cellular telephone use is strongly discouraged throughout the club. Repeated offensive use may result in suspension.
- 14) Member lists may not be used for any means other than club business.
- 15) It is your obligation to repair ball marks, divots and to rake bunkers. Bunkers must be entered and exited from the low side. Do not walk up the face of a bunker.
- 16) Single players and two-somes have no standing on the golf course. They are encouraged to make groups of three or four. No group of players may be composed of more than four players.
- 17) Practice on any part of the golf course is prohibited. Players having holed out shall not play their putts over again nor linger on the green when other players are following them.
- 18) Violations of Rules and Bylaws or inappropriate behavior towards other members, employees or guests may conclude with a warning, probation, or, if circumstances warrant, as determined by the manager in his sole discretion, expulsion from the club without prior warning and without refund of annual membership fees.
- 19) **All accounts must be paid in full on or prior to the 15th of the following month. Failure to do so may result in the termination of charging privileges (which includes access to the golf course) or suspension of membership.**
